

This document is the response of the Athens Town Administration, dated 25 October 1951, to an application made by Ambrosios (Miltiades) Katinakis in which he claimed his right to use the grave bought by (his grandmother) Franca Katinakis at the 1st Athens Cemetery as his family grave.

The document refers to the (simultaneous) purchase in 1867 of the two adjacent graves, that of Stephen Agelasto and that of Franca Katinakis. Both graves had the same surface (4.20 sq. m. each) and the same price (100 Drachmas each).

BUT the Cemetery Administration found out later that both graves together had a bigger surface (9.70 sq. m.) than the one paid for (8.40 sq. m.).

So the answer to Ambrosios' application was:

YES, you may use that grave as your family grave under the condition you pay for the exceeding surface!
