Derby hereby draw up & write by my own hand this present Will by  
which I express my last desire about the disposal of my fortune after my  
decease First I acknowledge as my heirs my children Stephen John Helene  
Cyron Aspasia & Lucia my other two daughters Henriette & Despina having  
at the time of their marriage had their share I do not bequeath anything  
to them I do hereby bequeath to my eldest son Stephen five thousand  
pounds sterling also five thousand pounds to my son John also five

thousand pounds to my daughter Helene, also five thousand pounds to my son  
Tryfon four thousand five hundred pounds to my daughter Aspasia four thousand  
five hundred pounds to my daughter Lucia also four thousand five hundred  
pounds to my wife Lucia besides her dower two thousand pounds & all the  
furniture silver plate &c. I order as my procurators & EXECUTORS of my  
Will M<sup>r</sup>. Nicholas Paspatti & M<sup>r</sup>. Constantine M. Halli & also my son  
Stephen In witness whereof I have drawn up my present Will as afore-  
said & signed same at the end with two witnesses the place where has  
been made out & the respective date - Liverpool township of West Derby  
this day the fourth of October of the year one thousand eight hundred
